

# Okra HIRE

*Abelmoschus caillei* L.

"A compact and productive okra, even in hot conditions"



This variety, coming from Ivory Coast, produces compact octagonal fruits with thin ending. It remains very productive even under hot conditions.

## Plant

- Branched
- Green to dark green stems with red spots

## Leaves

- Dark green with red veins
- Bicolour petiole



## Fruit

- Compact with thin ending
- Octagonal shape
- Slightly hairy
- Dark green

## Maturity

- 60 to 65 days after sowing (according to climate and country conditions)

## Crop cycle

- 110 to 150 days (according to climate and country conditions)
